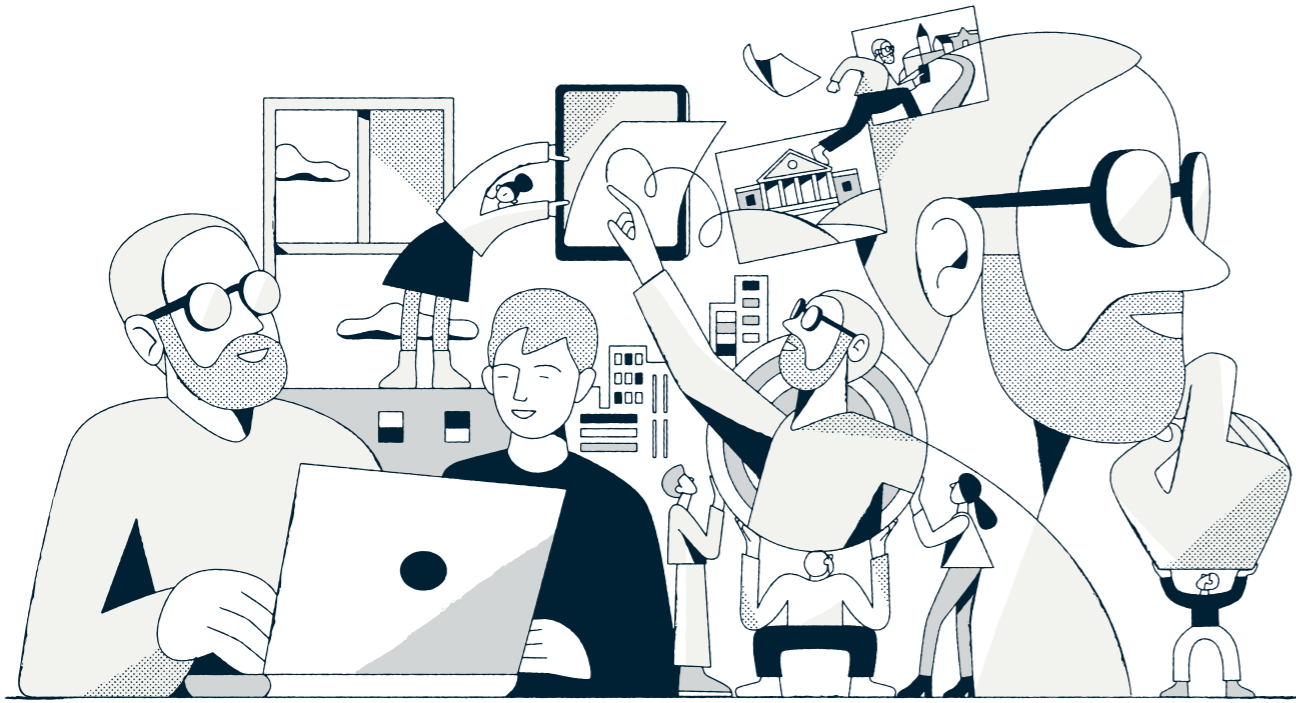

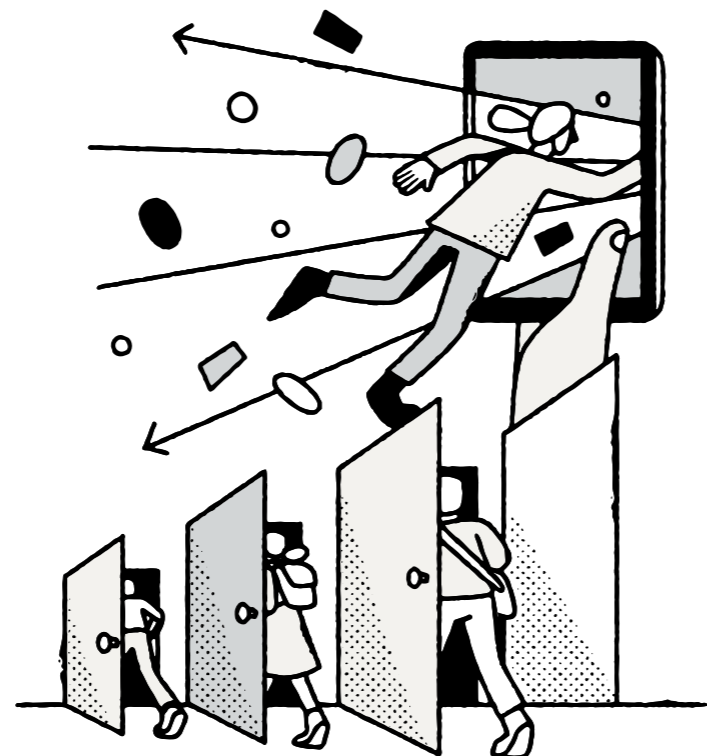

How to Apply

We have regional teams located across the world ready to assist your students with their applications and to offer advice throughout the admission process.

- 1** **Submit Application**

If you are a counselor submitting an application on behalf of your student, log into the Admissions Portal at admissions.shorelight.com and complete the online application. Don't have login credentials? Reach out to your regional admissions representative.

Students who wish to apply directly should visit shorelight.com to complete an online application.
- 2** **Submit Official Transcripts**

The student's original transcripts must be reviewed by an authorized recruiter, public notary, or regional office and be certified. Once certified, these can be scanned and uploaded to the Admissions Portal as part of the application process.
- 3** **Submit Proof of English-Language Ability**

If the student's native language is not English, please submit proof of their English-language ability. A full list of accepted tests can be found on the university's page on shorelight.com.
- 4** **Confirm Enrollment**

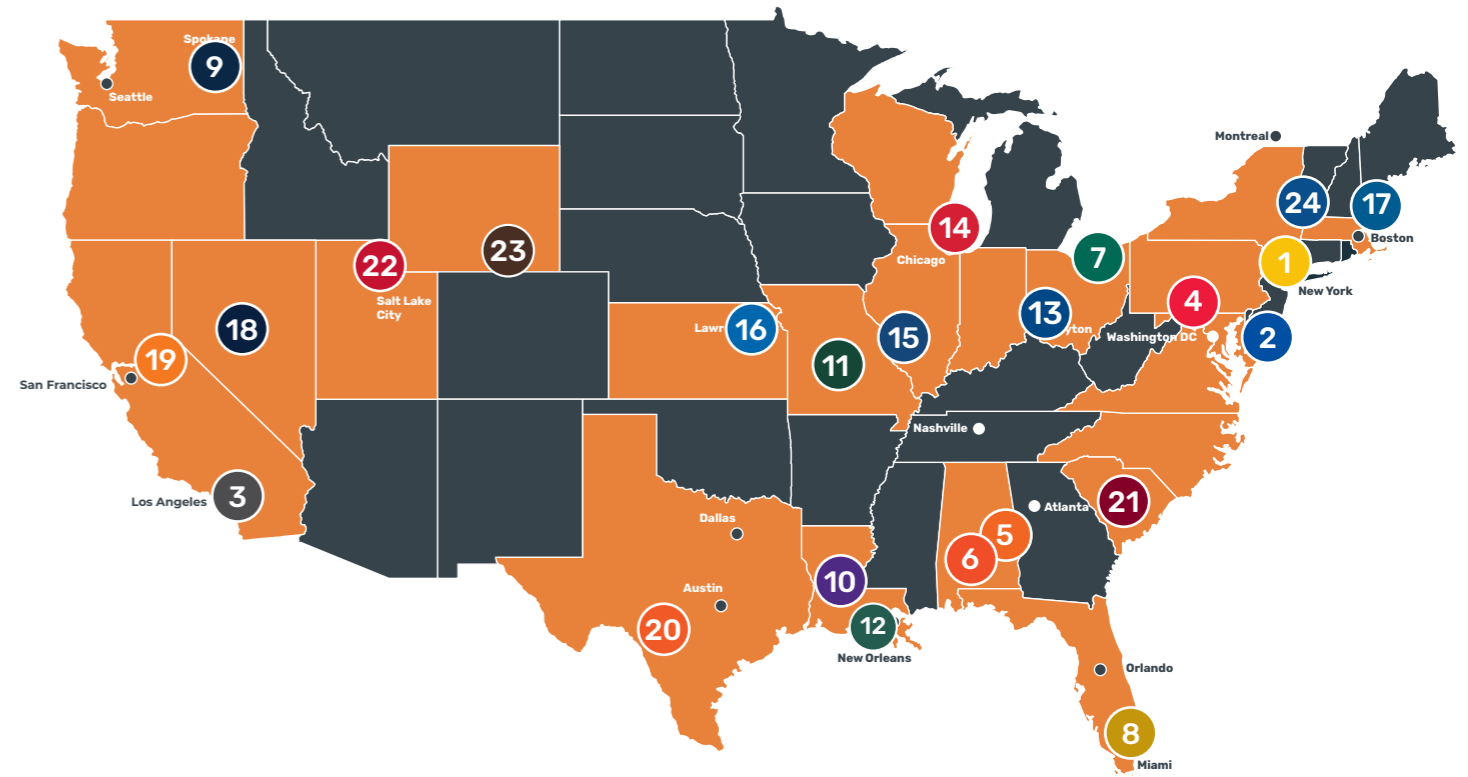
After the student's conditional offer is received, the student must confirm their enrollment by submitting a deposit and/or enrollment confirmation form.
- 5** **Provide Required Documents**

The student must submit an I-20 Request form, Certificate of Finances (COF), and bank statements in order to receive their I-20 to apply for a visa. Housing and dining forms must also be submitted to receive a final Statement of Fees.
- 6** **Apply for a Visa**

Once the student has been officially admitted to a program, the admissions team will send required documents to the student's home address to apply for visa processing with the US embassy in the student's home country.
